RE: Alberta Precision Laboratories Ltd.

This Note to File applies to corporate name change Alberta Precision Laboratories (APL) and the FDA1572 form:

APL is a provincially integrated model, ensuring consistency and coordination of high quality lab medicine services, consolidating the work previously provided by multiple organizations in Alberta (including Alberta Health Services (AHS), Calgary Lab Services (CLS), Covenant Health, and Lamont Health Care Centre). APL also continues to work collaboratively with DynaLife, under contract to provide lab services in Alberta. As such, multiple sites within the Edmonton region may be used to process and test samples and can be listed on the Form FDA 1572.

Effective October 23, 2019 Alberta Public Laboratories Ltd. changed its corporate name to Alberta Precision Laboratories Ltd. Alberta Precision Laboratories Ltd. (APL) remains the same corporate entity at law. Existing contracts under APL's previous name are still legally binding on APL and are not impacted by the corporate name change. For administrative efficiencies, APL, will not be amending existing contracts to reflect the name change. Future APL contracts will be issued under the new name.

All current, approved documents of the former AHS and APL remain valid and in place until superseded. As APL policies, processes and procedures are developed and approved, legacy documentation of the former laboratory entity will be archived.
